

SELECTBOARD - June 8, 2017- 8am

Call to order 8:07 AM

- The SB approved the last meeting's Minutes.
- Road signs: The action item for signs is now to gather the names of signs needed for all roads (missing and replacing) so an order can be made. This is on John's radar.
- John will seek another estimate for repainting the cupola on the Town Hall, and also for painting the roof.
- The Selectboard approved a quote from Mark Waldo for mowing Leurich Field 2x a month.
- Health officer Cameron Chalmers reports via email that he has had good contact with Clarie Munat at White Pine Lodge regarding her failed septic system. The tank has been pumped and Cam recommended some engineers and site technicians. Claire will next report back when she has contacted them. The Selectboard recognizes the work that Cameron is doing and is content to let him continue to handle it and there is no need to take it to the state level at this time.
- Road Commissioner Steve Hall reported about the bridge paving bids and will choose the bid and order the paving next week to get on the paving company's summer schedule.
- Selectboard signed pay orders.
- The Selectboard reappointed Karl Pfister as Town Fire Warden for another 5 years.
- The Board reviewed the Zoning Bylaws - John Ogden feels the 75' setback is too far and that a lower setback, such as 50' would be more appropriate in the Rural Residential zones. Zoning Administrator Hal Wilkins will bring this to the Planning and Zoning Commission and if the change is agreed upon, will make that adjustment administratively, not requiring further review and approval.
- Delinquent Tax Collector Andrea Ogden briefed the Selectboard on the procedures for today's tax sale, commencing at 10am.
