

Minutes of the Landgrove Cemetery Commission August 21 2014

attended by Clarence Nichols, Lynn Eckhardt, May Bigelow, and John English

Meeting began at 10:40 and adjourned at 11:10

Builder: Brownie Bacon believes that he should not try to build our wall, therefore Cameron Chalmers has appointed Luke Bonang to the task

Progress: Some of the old chain link fence has been removed and about 100 feet of a beautiful rustic stone wall has been completed along the roadway

Height: Design considerations were discussed, the wall along the road is 36 inches high inside, while the side walls will be 24 inches high

Donations: \$19700 has been received

Costs: \$14509 has been billed, most of this cost is for the transportation of donated stones to the job site

Gate: Requests for estimates of a wrought iron type gate have been submitted to three companies, we are waiting for two responses

Expansion: Ideas were presented for an expansion near the present parking area, this area would provide for more burial lots and a small rest area

Monk: We thank Monk Ogden for his volunteer work, his guidance will insure a successful and well-built stone wall

Next: We plan to complete the wall along the road, shape the two east corners, and place the base stones on the north side to the main gate this year

Future: Implement Cameron's' idea about planting some shade trees, investigate engineering for a new site map, and consider mailing another letter
