

Minutes- Selectboard 6PM April 28 2016

1. Call to order - 6:08 PM- Attendance: Greg Eckhardt, Chrystal Cleary, Jeremiah Evarts
2. Motion to approve previous meeting's minutes- unanimously approved
3. Jeremiah Evarts has spoken with Cy Bailey, the district advisor to the Listers, regarding the town property assessments in light of the court decision on the Laverack appeal. The Selectboard still stands by our Listers. Mr Bailey has been invited to attend and speak at the next evening Selectboard Meeting (6pm, Thursday May 26) and the public is welcome and encouraged to attend and ask questions.
4. Neighbor complaint about septic odors at the White Pine Lodge- Town Health Officer Cameron Chalmers is attempting to connect with Clare Munat to find out what steps have been taken and what steps are next to achieve function and compliance with septic regulations. Dorr was at the Lodge on Monday the 25th, possibly pumping or evaluating the system.
5. Jeremiah Evarts spoke with Troy Dare regarding the installation of a dry hydrant in Town and will call him to invite him to look at possible siting of a hydrant to increase water access for fire fighting capability in town.
6. Roads: Greg got the application in for Bridge grants, and Jay completed the application for a Roads grant this month. Possibly dangerous trees have been identified on Hapgood Pond Road and Old County Road that Jeremiah will ask Steve to look at.
7. County Forester Kyle Mason, Cameron Chalmers and Jeremiah Evarts met on April 21 to walk through and discuss the timber harvest, thinning and bench siting for Evarts Memorial Forest.
8. Leurich Field siting of Town salt shed looks inadequate after Chris Heinz marked out the 50' wetland setbacks. In the long term we feel it is important to cover our supplies, but are running dry on suitable sites. Suggestions welcome.
9. Greg Eckhardt is going to price out two flags with stands for the schoolroom at Town Hall.
