

Select Board Meeting May 14, 2015

Attendance: John Ogden, Greg Eckhardt, Jeremiah Evarts, Selectmen. Seth Bigelow, Conservation Commission. Andrea Ogden, Treasurer and Chrystal Cleary, Clerk. Clarence Nichols, Lynn Eckhardt, Cemetery Commission
Meeting called to order at 8:04am.

Minutes from the previous meeting were approved. Pay orders approved.

Cemetery Commissioners Lynn Eckhardt and Clarence Nichols presented their efforts to solicit 6 bids for the job of completing the cemetery stonewall. Based on appearance and low bid, Clarence has asked Cameron Chalmers to do the work. Lynn has written a fundraising letter for the remainder needed to complete the job.

A summer contract (vs hourly pay) for road maintenance is being explored- hours, work to do, length, and pay data is being collected and considered to see if this is a good way for the Town to operate with regard to summer roadwork.

Comfort Forest- The Town has received the appraisal done on behalf of the Morfit family, and the land value and sale price were discussed. John will contact the Morfits with the Town's reply.

Seth Bigelow reminded the board that on Monday May 18th at 3pm Kyle Mason will be conducting a walkthrough at Evarts Forest and encouraged everyone to go look at the Resource Assessment and Plan attached to his recent email. Seth will invite abutters to the walk through (Andrea will provide Seth with the emails of adjacent landowners) and Chrystal will post the walkthrough announcement to the Town Website.

There has been no communication yet from Cameron regarding the June 1 deadline to move his business vehicles and supplies from his Landgrove property. An inspection after that date will be conducted by John LaVecchia.

The select board voted to move into Executive Session.
