

Selectboard Meeting June 13 2019, 8am

- Last meeting's minutes approved
- Demski's Ditch- as in other properties in town, the Town will repair the ditch, and improve it, but the gravel/material that the flood washed into the woods exceeds the scope of work. Steve and Michael have been following up with Mr Demski.
- No progress on the Sandbox/Road Barn project this time, but a few parcels have some promise. Hal has been speaking with the Forest Service, who have been cooperative. We may need to mail out a town-wide request for land to show them that we have so few possibilities in town to work with that arranging something with the USFS may be our only remaining choice.
- Internet connectivity- Comcast remains uninterested/unresponsive to our plight. Consolidated is still working up a proposal. VTel is lovely but would require legislative redistricting of carrier territories to work with us, and we don't have the legislative clout to get that going.
- Window restoration- a contractor has been selected, Tom McLoughlin LLC, and he will begin the job mid-late July!
- Marc Waldo will be called upon to mow Leurich Field in time for it to look great for July 4th
- Pay orders signed
- The Municipal Roads Grants in Aid participation intent form was signed and mailed out, for stone lined ditching on Hapgood Pond Rd.
