Call to order: 8:05am

- Last meeting's minutes approved
- The Board signed the Letter of Intent for the Municipal Roads Grants-in-aid Program for the new Vermont Stormwater runoff rules. This Letter will be sent to DEC with a check for \$240 today.
- Zoning Administrator Hal Wilkins distributed the state maps of ideal solar locations in Landgrove, and described the process and considerations going forward for the Town to allowing/prohibiting industrial solar installations greater than 15 kw by property owners. The matter is going to go before the Planning Commission. Wind power installations are not yet under discussion but a similar map and process will be coming for wind as well.
- The Board appointed Mary Licata to the Planning Commission.
- The Selectmen have been out to a property near the village on Ridge Road to consider for a site for the Town Road Barn. They feel the site is workable and will speak with the property owners and stake out the area.
- Delinquent Tax Collector Andrea reported on the status of the 4 properties currently delinquent. The required year has passed since the tax sale of the Whitten property to Soucy.
- The Vermont Preservation Trust came by to look at the big windows in the schoolroom to assess their historic nature (or not). While the windows are not original, they are considered historic because in the 1930's when the building became a school the state required certain kinds of windows for good lighting for all school buildings, and these windows were put in. This is sufficiently 'historic' to require preservation and make the project eligible for matching grants.
