

Selectboard Meeting, July 23 2020 8am

Attendance: Steve Hall, Michael Jeffery, John Ogden, Chrystal Cleary, Andrea Ogden, Nancie Heinneman

Item #1: Nancie H. described the dangers of vehicles speeding down the hill on Landgrove Road out of Weston, and how this impacts safety of pedestrians, children, horses. The speed limit for this road is 35 mph. Michael will check with VTrans about the enforce-ability and appropriateness of speed limits on dirt roads in Vermont, and the SB will review speed ordinances with an eye toward extending the 25 mph limit that begins in the village along Landgrove road to just above Pfister Pfarm. Other possibilities could include signage, or renting a digital speed radar sign.

Item #2: Pay orders were signed. Treasurer Andrea explained the application of a refund check to Mr Good for an appeal judgement from the state but that had not been applied when it was formalized last year in 2019.

Item # 3: The tax rate is not ready to be determined yet, because there's a chain of steps between the Listers and the state PVR/current use that have to finish first.

Item #4: Sandbox stuff: Michael is in touch with a property owner about a likely parcel, and needed clarification on requirements: surveying, perc test, etc. The board discussed other requirements- such as sprinklers, well, septic, permits, lighting, etc.
