- The Town of Landgrove is saddened to learn of the passing of our Zoning Administrator, Hal Wilkins. No funeral or memorial plans are known at this time. Chrystal will contact Missy to inquire.
- Will Goodwin introduced himself to the board as a possible candidate to succeed Hal. Will is currently ZA in Weston.
