- Pay orders- none
- Signatures from Chrystal
- Mud Season Repair
  - Leurich Field: Jay fixed damage
- Hazard Mitigation Plan- John, Susan
  - Update – This is the Town Disaster Recovery Plan. Town must have one on file to receive funding.
  - Susan reviewed email from John and historical folder from Andrea to ascertain next steps. Susan requested any existing bids and will collect two others and keep track of timing.
- Badger access – Ridge Road
- Road grants program- signed to signify intent to participate
  - The Vermont Agency of Transportation (AOT) invites municipalities to participate in the Municipal Roads, Grants-in-Aid Program, which provides funding for municipalities to implement best management practices (BMPs) in accordance with the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Municipal Roads General Permit (MRGP).
- Peru- Borrow debris blower- Agreed upon to loan out
- Discuss Town maps – Steve – Will evolve over the summer
  - Progressing with updating the road maps- working with Pam, waiting to see if the actual revised mileage is correct.
  - Mileage and possible reclassifications to TH6 (Old County East) and TH12 Landgrove Hollow. Our Town Highway maps are incorrect. Class 4 roads need potential reclassification to Class 3.
- Potential access for farm stand on Old County Road- discussed and denied- advised to apply to zoning in the future
- Sandbox land
  - Jason worked on the permit, need to get wetlands permit due to the water present, Steve will touch base with the planning commission regarding the subdivision project
- Flagpole request (Rob Badger)
  - The flagpole at the monument in the village needs to be replaced due to breakage in two spots. Rob has agreed to take point on the repair.
- Internet line for Town Hall
  - Susan submitted signed form to CCI for processing. She will keep the SB apprised of progress as a regular point of discussion
