

Minutes- Selectboard 8AM September 8, 2016

1. Call to order - 8:08 AM- Attendance: Greg Eckhardt, John Ogden, Jeremiah Everts (by phone), Chrystal Cleary, Andrea Ogden, Steve Hall
2. The Selectboard approved previous meeting's minutes.
3. Select board signed pay orders.
4. Mary English has voiced concerns about the Planning Commission and the Bylaw Revision process. Jerry will contact Mary directly, as well as Malcolm McNair. Possible new members were considered to approach for service.
5. Speed Hump- John O. will draft a response to the letter of Beveley Stone. The hump will remain where it is for a few more weeks and be removed for the winter before the ground hardens (end of October) and its pros and cons will be discussed at Town Meeting in the Spring.
6. Road signs have been requested by residents of Sled Run and Red Pine Drive, however both of these are private roads. Questions arose- are private roads required to have signs (say, for 911 purposes?) and is it the responsibility the Town or the residents to purchase them? Steve is going to look deeper into the road sign issues. John will identify roads that currently do not have signs in place. The Board should be able to make a decision by the next meeting about what, if any, signs the town will buy.

Winter crowning and ditching were discussed by Steve and the board, as well as work done in the Grant Area, and the attributes of gravel purchased from various sources to see which suits the Town's roads. Steve reports that Pala Mostoller confronted the road crew about her concerns with dust and road speed resulting from the grading work, and he has invited her to share her concerns with him or the Selectboard and not the road crew.

Steve will be following up with the grants and determine what needs to be done to start the work and how to get the town paid.

7. BCA appeals have concluded and decisions were sent by certified mail on Thursday September 1.
